**DRIVING/PARKING INSTRUCTIONS TO THE NATIONAL  
CRYPTOLOGIC MUSEUM**

Everyone is requested to drive to and park behind the Museum. You can access the Museum by way of Canine Road, off of Rt. 32. There will be signage directing you to park as well as members of the Commuter Transportation Office and Security there to assist you.

You will enter the rear entrance of the Museum to pick up your name decal in the Magic Room. Decals will be prepared based upon your registration form. Please be sure to bring your photo ID to present to Security.

Once you receive your decal, please exit the same rear door and get on a shuttle bus where you will be taken to the R&E Building, and escorted by members of the Protocol Office to the Symposium Center.

FIRST SHUTTLE BUS DEPARTS THE MUSEUM AT 0715; LAST SHUTTLE DEPARTS THE MUSEUM AT 0815. Shuttle service will return you back to the Museum beginning at 1100. There will be no early departures back to the Museum unless there is an emergency.

As a reminder, cell phones, fitbits, smart watches, or any other recording device should remain in your car – these items are still restrictive. In the event of inclement weather and the Agency declares a CODE ORANGE (delayed opening), NSA Retirees Day will be cancelled. You may call the Agency's Snow Line at 301-688-7669 to verify a delayed opening or closure.
