In 2014, a visit to Olivia's pediatrician revealed a large, abdominal lump in her stomach. Within hours, test confirmed a Wilms tumor had taken over her kidney, and doctors admitted her to Johns Hopkins Children's Center to discuss treatment of her stage-four cancer.

3 days later, Olivia underwent a successful surgery to remove a nearly 2 pound tumor and her right kidney.



For the following 7 months, Olivia received chemotherapy at the JHCC.

Today, Olivia is in remission and returns to the JHCC every 3 months for screenings. Olivia is incredibly close to her brother Lucas, and is an absolute sweetheart that shares her love and joy with everyone she meets. She is always eager to give hugs, enjoys doing arts and crafts and loves spending time with her family.
