Dr. Matthew Kuan Johnson serves as Chief of Responsible AI (RAI) for the U.S. Department of War (DoW). As the DoW's lead for Responsible AI and AI Assurance, his Division builds the technical tools, best practices, and policies to assess and assure the DoW's AI-enabled capabilities. His Division also developed the DoW's Responsible AI Toolkit (a focal point of the 'Secure-by-Design' portion of America's AI Action plan), issued the DoW's policy on Generative AI, and leads Frontier AI Red Teaming for the Department.

Dr. Johnson also chairs the White House's CAIO Council Al Assurance Working Group, which is tasked with developing resources to enable

compliance with the Federal Government's AI risk requirements.

Dr. Johnson holds a Ph.D. in Philosophy from the University of Cambridge, as well as degrees in Cognitive Science from the University of Cambridge (M.Phil.) and Yale University (B.A.). Previously, he consulted for Google AI and was a Research Fellow at the University of Oxford. His areas of specialty include AI-enabled autonomy, human-agent interaction, AI red teaming, and AI ethics.
