Colonel Parker Hitt - A Cryptologic Pioneer, Cryptologic Dad, & "Father of Modern American Cryptology."

You might remember this photo from our Mother's Day e-newsletter as it features Genevieve and Parker Hitt with their family. Just as Genevieve was a cryptologic mom, **Parker was a cryptologic Dad!** The couple were an inspiration to their daughter, who went on to work for William Friedman at Arlington Hall Station. But Col Parker Hitt was also referred to by the Friedmans as the **"Father of modern American cryptology."** His work, "The Manual for the Solution of Military Ciphers," published in 1916, was the first of its kind in the United States in 100 years and laid the foundation for the nation's impressive cryptologic achievements during the 20th century. At a time when the nation had no formal cryptologic service, Parker Hitt's innovative work documented concepts and principles that would be used to protect U.S. military communications for decades. Col Parker Hitt was recognized in the Cryptologic Hall of Honor in 2011.
