Alexis leads Al Adoption & Deployment and the U.S. National Labs Partnership for OpenAl for Government. She was Google's Emerging Technology Evangelist driving Al Adoption in the Public Sector, and the Chief Innovation Officer of USAID, where she launched 10 Grand Challenges and Prizes and catalyzed over \$2B in innovative technologies.

As the CIO of the Air Force Research Lab, Alexis introduced the first large scale LLM to DOD and ran the Al Adoption Research Platform, training more than 30,000 service men and women and public leaders in Al. She helped found the US Global Development Lab and was the Country Director for UNOPS in West Bank/Gaza. She served in various roles in the UN in over 20 countries and has brought technologies to war-zones, the Ebola crisis, and global disasters including a tsunami, major earthquakes, fires, famines, and floods.

Alexis has been in technology application and adoption since the 90's. Her first job was at the Internet Trade Association where she introduced "The Internet" to Corporate America. The entirety of her career has been helping people, communities, companies, and nations navigate technology, especially AI.

Alexis has her MBA from Kellogg Northwestern, Masters in Interactive and Direct Marketing from NYU, and an Honorary Doctorate from Shepherd University.
